The salary schedule below has been developed to provide some standardization into the payments made to certificated personnel for services performed outside of the school day and outside their contract.

Arrangements for payments for service must be made in advance of any service performed with approval from a budget director.

The following payment schedule will be in effect starting June 1, 1987:

1. Summer Teaching Assignment--\$8.90 per hour.
2. Teams producing material for District consumption--\$45.00 per day for six-hour day.
3. School teams planning and producing material for use in their school building--\$40 per day for a six-hour day.
4. Preparation of testing materials, administration of tests and grading of tests for credit challenges will be by individual contract arrangement between the Secondary Curriculum Coordinator and person performing the task. The basis will be to approximate \$8.90 per hour for development, monitoring, and checking with a maximum of \$50 expenditure for the development, monitoring and grading of the test for one course.
5. Mutual agreement contracting for services between the teacher and the budget director responsible for the service may take the place of the above schedule. However, payment is not to exceed the above schedule.
