The Board of Trustees of School District No. 25 directs the development of a Parent Advisory Council in all District schools.

A district-wide Parent Advisory Council composed of representatives from each of the individual school councils and other members of the community may be formed by the Superintendent of Schools.

The purpose of the Parent Advisory Council is to:

- a. Arouse the interest of citizens in educational affairs and operation of individual schools and the school system as a whole.
- b. Involve citizens in an advisory capacity in problems and important decisions confronting their school.
- c. Develop better understanding among homes, schools, and staff.
- d. Gain citizen support through unified action.
