Operation and Maintenance of District Facilities

The District seeks to maintain and operate facilities in a safe and healthful condition. The District, in cooperation with the principals, state, county and local agencies, shall periodically, and at least annually, inspect plant and facilities. The District shall provide for a program to maintain the educational facilities by way of a continuous program of repair, maintenance and reconditioning. The District shall maintain adequate and timely operation of the heating/ventilation/air conditioning systems in addition to proper care of floors, walls, roofs and other necessary facility needs, including equipment and grounds/play ground areas. Budget recommendations shall be made each year to meet these needs and any such needs arising from an emergency.

The District shall formulate and implement energy conservation measures. Principals and staff are encouraged to exercise other cost-saving procedures in order to conserve the resources of the District in their buildings.

Because of the nature of facility operations, this service shall be provided not only during the normal scheduled working day and working year, but shall also occur during those times when the building is occupied outside of regular hours.
