NUMBER OF DAYS

Certificated employees will be allocated sick leave per the negotiated agreement. Sick leave may accumulate to the current amount listed in the negotiated contract for certificated employees.

The Board may require proof of illness adequate to protect the district against malingering and false claims of illness.

BASIS FOR SICK LEAVE-DEFINITION

Sick leave is defined as: (a) illness of the employee, (b) illness of a member of the employee's family, including: spouse, employee or spouse's child, parents, brother or sister when living in the same household as the employee, and (c) bereavement.

Sick leave may be allowed at the discretion of the Superintendent, or designee, for illness of family members (i.e., employee or spouse's child, parent, brother, sister) not living within the same household.

TRANSFER OF SICK LEAVE

Transfer of Sick Leave will be allowed per Idaho Code.
