

## STUDENT VEHICLES

Adopted October, 1977	Student vehicles

Each year we face the problem of control and security of student automobiles and motorized vehicles. The school has jurisdiction of students from the time they arrive at school until their departure each school day. It is therefore necessary to have a clear understanding of the schools position and extent of responsibility concerning motorized vehicles and motorized vehicle related incidents during the school day.

The schools' position is as follows:

1. The school will assume no responsibility for the security of any vehicle or any vehicle related incident for vehicles while parked on or off the school campus.
2. The school reserves the right to remove vehicles, at student expense, which are parked in restricted areas. Restricted areas will be identified with appropriate markings.
3. Vehicles should not be moved or occupied by students during any part of the school day when such students would normally be expected to be in attendance at scheduled school functions.

Violation of any portion of this policy will be considered a discipline problem and could result in suspension or expulsion as outlined in Policy and Procedure 8210, "Student Discipline."
