Some classes can be taken before the regular school day begins. Early Morning classes are optional.

Two (2) additional math credits and two (2) additional science credits are required to earn the minimum credits for entrance to Idaho’s four-year colleges. Be aware that out-of-state colleges have other admission requirements.

Speech (1credit) is required and may be taken in grade 9, 10, 11, or 12.

Economics and **Health** (1credit each) are required and may be taken in grades 10, 11 or 12.

9th grade U.S. History counts as 2 of the 4 history credits; it does not count as a humanities credit.

2 Credits of **Humanities** must be taken for graduation.

Each student must complete elective credit in at least 2 of the following areas of instructional offerings:

- Physical Education (fitness)
- Humanities (Drama, Art, Music, Foreign Language, World History)
- Professional-Technical Education (including work-based learning)
- Family and Consumer Science
- Fine and Performing Arts
- Languages other than English

Students must earn **42 credits** to graduate with a standard diploma. Students in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12 will be required to register for a six-period day with the option of an approved release. All 42 credits must be totally completed prior to graduation exercises.
